CA	CSL	AP5	Proposed	Labeling of Prescription Medications: This measure would require physicians and surgeons to include the purpose of the medication on the prescription label.
CA	CSL	SP4	Proposed	Financial Support of CSL: This measure would require Department of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates to provide funding.
CA	CSL	AP18	Proposed	Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Centers: Would fund Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Center Programs.
CA	CSL	SP1	Proposed	Alzheimer Research Funding: This measure will allocate \$10 million per year for next three years to fund non-pharmacological Alzheimer research
CA	CSL	AP1:	Proposed	Tenancy- Extended Notice Period: This measure would allow seniors and individuals with disabilities the option to extend the vacate notice period up to 6 months in order to relocate.
CA	CSL	AP19	Proposed	Medi-Cal Long-Term Care Personal Needs Allowance This measure would increase personal needs allowance from \$35 to \$80 per month and annually adjust personal needs allowance by some percentage of the Customer Price Index.
CA	CSL	AP16	Proposed	Mobile Home Residency Rights: This measure would authorize any homeowner to share the mobile home with one guest and would delete the requirement of a written treatment plan by a physician.
CA	CSL	AP7	Proposed	Identify Theft: This measure would create a 2 year sentence enhancement for conviction of a crime against a person 65 years or older and results in a financial loss of \$25,000.
CA	CSL	AP20	Proposed	Personal Income Tax Credit: Caregivers: This measure will allow an eligible caregiver a credit against personal income taxes proposed for a taxable year equal to 30% of qualified expenses.
CA	CSL	AP2	Proposed	Unit Pricing: This measure will require the Department of Food and Agriculture to create a standardized format for product pricing available to consumers.

CA		AB 71	Chiu +	Bring California Home Act: provides ongoing affordable housing by eliminating state mortgage interest deduction on vacation homes.
CA		AB 73	Chiu +	Increased Enforcement of Existing State Housing Laws: This bill appropriates funds to the Attorney General (AG) to enforce existing state housing laws.
CA		AB 74	Chiu +	Housing for a Healthy California: Creates the Housing for a Healthy California program to pay for the cost of housing chronically homeless individuals on Medi-Cal who receive services through the Whole Person Care pilot program, Health Homes, or another county controlled funding source.
CA		SB 35	Weiner	Housing Affordability and Accountability: Will streamline production of affordable housing and spur construction of housing throughout CA. Will remove local barriers to creating affordable housing, as well as barriers in jurisdictions failing to build housing needed to meet Regional includes a provision that all these requirements are subject to the payment of prevailing wages to workers building the housing.
CA		SB 8		Mental Health Diversion: This bill would authorize a court, with the consent of the defendant and a waiver of the defendant's speedy trial right, to postpone prosecution of a misdemeanor or a felony punishable in a county jail, and place the defendant in a pretrial diversion program if the court is satisfied the defendant suffers from a mental disorder, that the defendant's mental disorder played a significant role in the commission of the charged offense, and that the defendant would benefit from mental health treatment
US	CSL	AFP1	Proposed	Labeling of Prescription Drugs: This measure requires medication so prescribed to include the purpose for which prescribed on the label.
US	CSL	SFP3	Proposed	Social Security Burial Benefits: This measure would raise Social Security Burial amount to \$495.
US	CSL	SFP2	Proposed	Veterans Pension Benefits: This measure would require the US Department of Veterans Affairs to ensure each Veteran receives full pension benefits and upon death become the property of the estate.
US	CSL	AFP2	Proposed	Durable Medical Equipment - Grab Bars: This measure would request the Federal Government to adopt appropriate regulations to add grab bars to list of durable medical equipment.
