#### **Budget Asks (suggestions and comments)**

Note: Work Group concluded that whenever and wherever possible our recommendation would be to work with existing services as opposed to creating new ones.

\$250,000 for Mental health and Psychosocial Services

Includes Case Management (2 staff)

Need support groups (12 to 15 people)

One clinical staff: \$80,000

Transportation: need door-to-door van

Housing

To reduce homelessness via eviction prevention and housing off the streets

HIV Housing Ask: 3.7 Million 1<sup>st</sup> year

20 Million ongoing housing subsidies (deep affordability)

ROAH II Needs Assessment \$250,000

\$132,000 personnel

\$500 IRB

5 focus groups plus incentives
