LTCCC Budget Asks Report Back

LTCCC requesting Work group prioritize and summarize budget requests. Housing received highest LTCCC priority. HIV & Aging may not be a specific priority for the LTCCC but DAAS, Mayor's Office and Dignity Fund looking at 5 -7 buckets. HIV/Aging is in the mix.

ROAH 2

Vince & Chip met with Shireen McSpadden, interim Executive Director of DAAS, last Thursday 3/3. She is interested in funding ROAH 2 and is looking for the money and process ways to do so.
