July 11, 2016 Meeting Notes

Welcome and Introductions

Dignity Fund Update

Vince reported that negotiations have brought forward a bill supported by all; a vote will be taken on July 19 around 2pm. A Dignity Fund meeting will be held on July 13 at 2:30pm (825 Howard). There is a City Hall Rally at 12:30pm prior to the vote.

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ROAH 2

Vince announced that Meals on Wheels will act as ROAH fiscal agent. ACRIA will have local staff to collect data: 20 surveys and 5 top 6 focus groups by November. Further updates are to come and work on focus group content in August.

Budget Update

- \$1 million for eviction defense and tenant education (\$380,000)
- \$3 million for housing subsidies (Mayor/Board) Also \$500,000 subsidies for people losing disability benefits(Wiener)
- \$350,000 Housing modification grants for renters and homeowners
- \$1.65 million housing support project
- \$3 million for food security
- Several million for homeless emergency
- \$500,000 for SRO Elevator fund (per Victoria, need outreach)
- Monies for HIV/AIDS including \$90,000 for HIV & Aging

Barry Roeder, now with the Mayor's Office on Housing and Community Development gave an overview of the affordable housing database. Important principles applied include user centric (face to face feedback aka Google Bridge model), No jargon, Robust (e.g. short form common application, electronic lotteries, ability to update existing applications and apply to various available units, and no dead ends (includes where else a user can go and what other services are available.) Barry also noted that a report on the 5 year HIV Housing plan is due.
