PCC EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ELECTIONS

The PCC Executive Committee is a 36-member council with diverse representation from consumer and advocacy groups, as well as public organizations. At this year’s Annual Meeting, the following seats will be up for election for a two-year term unless otherwise indicated.

Unaffiliated Elderly: Any San Francisco resident over 60.	6	6
Non-Profit Provider: A non-profit organization that provides transportation services to elderly or disabled persons.	1	2

NOMINATIONS FOR THE PCC EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Nomination forms must be submitted no later than Wednesday, November 2, 2017 to be listed on the ballot at the Annual Meeting. Nominations may also be submitted at the Annual Meeting. Candidates running for an affiliated position must provide a letter on organizational letterhead acknowledging that the candidate is a designated representative. To run for a position on the Executive Committee, candidates must first become a member of the PCC by calling 415.701.4597 or emailing jonathan.cheng@sfmta.com and submitting a PCC Executive Committee Nomination Form (see page 5) by November 2, 2017. All PCC members are eligible to vote by secret ballot in the Annual Meeting elections. The PCC By-Laws state that “no organization, agency or company may have more than one representative on the Executive Committee, nor it is the intent of the Executive Committee to have any organization, agency or company control the unaffiliated membership.” Candidates may not run for a position in more than one category.
