

**The San Francisco Giants are conducting an exercise that will test our plans for an evacuation at the ballpark.
We are actively seeking volunteers for this exercise.**

The exercise will be held at AT&T Park on February 10, 2018 following the KNBR 680/Giants FanFest and will begin at 3:30 p.m. and last approximately 2 hours. The KNBR 680/Giants FanFest is an opportunity for fans to gather at AT&T Park from 10-3 p.m., with free admission, to celebrate the start of the 2018 baseball season. Fans have the opportunity to be on the field, listen to the live radio interviews from KNBR 680's main stage, interact with many of the Giants players, coaches, broadcasters and alumni through designated autograph and Q&A sessions, take self-guided tours of the Giants Clubhouse, and visit various vendor booths and much more.

As a volunteer you will receive:

- A San Francisco Giants branded gift;
- Special entry to the KNBR 680/Giants Fan Fest; and
- Participate in an exciting exercise to test the evacuation plan for AT&T Park in order to ensure we are prepared for an emergency event.

Registration is from 12 p.m. until 3:15 p.m. at the 2nd and King entrance only. **All volunteers will go through our screening process (magnetometer and bag check).** As a volunteer you are welcome to participate in the KNBR 680/Giants Fan Fest activities until the exercise begins. Only those who are registered prior to the exercise will be allowed to stay on site after the KNBR 680/Giants Fan Fest. Please bring a printed copy or electronic version of your Eventbrite ticket.

We ask that all volunteers:

- Wear comfortable clothing that you don't mind getting a little dirty
- Only bring what you need to sustain for the 2 hour event - Hard sided coolers and bags larger than 16" x 16" x 8" are not permitted into the ballpark
- Stay for the entire 2-hour exercise

Kids **10 years and older** are welcome to register as volunteers as long as they are accompanied by an adult.
